3.	What is the essential educational qualification required?	The required qualifications are: Bachelor's Degree in Engineering (B.E.) or Bachelor's Degree in Technology (B. Tech) or Equivalent Degree/Qualification to B.E or B.Tech (as notified by Government from time to time) Provided that Candidate claiming equivalence of his qualification/ Degree to Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or Technology will have to necessarily produce the notification issued by Appropriate Authority, in support of his/ her claim of equivalence, at the time of interview failing which the candidature is liable to be rejected.
4.	What is the percentage of	The qualification requirement is "Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or Technology or equivalent for applying for the post with Civil Engineering, Instrumentation Engineering, Environmental Engineering and Textile Engineering discipline with not less than 60% marks in aggregate (50% for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) and for the post with Chemistry discipline, Master's Degree in Natural Sciences or equivalent [in Chemistry discipline only] with not less than sixty per cent marks in aggregate (50% for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes)
5.	Can candidates with 59.9 % marks in aggregate (49.9% marks for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) in Bachelor's degree in Engineering or Technology or equivalent degree apply?	No, the fraction of percentage will be ignored i.e. 59.99% will be treated as less than 60% and 49.99% will be treated as less than 50%.
6.	Can a student in final year of essential qualification degree apply?	No, the result should have been declared on or before 25 th June 2020.
7.	I have qualified GATE in year 2017. Can I apply?	No, the GATE Score must be valid as on 25th June 2020 .

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8.	I have degree in Instrumentation Engineering and have qualified GATE Paper in Electrical Engineering. Can I apply against Electrical Engineering discipline ?	No, the applicant must have valid GATE Score in the corresponding GATE Paper to the Discipline in which post is advertised. The corresponding GATE Paper and its Code against each Discipline Advertised in the Detailed Advertisement available on BIS Website.
9.	I have degree in Construction Engineering and have valid GATE Score in Civil Engineering (CE) Paper of GATE. Can I apply against Civil Engineering discipline?	No, the applicant must have degree in the concerned discipline against which the vacancy is advertised.
10.	I have B.E/ B. Tech degree in Civil and Construction Engineering and have valid GATE Score in Civil Engineering (CE) Paper of GATE. Can I apply against Civil Engineering discipline?	Yes, in case of dual specialization/ qualification, corresponding discipline advertised must be appearing as major specialization in the Essential Qualification Degree. Therefore in such cases of dual specialization where the discipline advertised (i.e. Civil Engineering etc) is also major specialization in the Essential Qualification Degree (i.e. B.E/ B. Tech degree), hence candidate is eligible to apply.
11.	Can a person having qualification in Bio- chemistry, Inorganic Chemistry etc discipline apply against post for Chemistry discipline?	No, the required degree must be in chemistry discipline only, as mentioned in Detailed Advertisement(hosted on BIS Website)under Essential Qualifications.
12.	What is the age limit and what is the cut-off date for age limit?	The upper age limit is 30 years as on 25th June 2021 .
13.	What relaxations in upper age limit are applicable and to which category of candidates?	Relaxation in upper age limit is applicable for following categories: a) Scheduled Castes b) Scheduled Tribes c) Other Backward Classes (non creamy layer) d) Person with Benchmark Disabilities e) Ex-Servicemen f) Departmental Candidates of BIS For further details, please refer to the detailed advertisement available on BIS Website: <u>www.bis.gov.in</u>

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14.	Is relaxation in upper age limit applicable to person presently employed with Central Government / State Government / Quasi Government Offices / Public Sector Undertakings?	No, there is no relaxation in upper age limit in such cases.
15.	Can a candidate who is crossing upper age limit by few days or months apply?	No, the candidates shall be within prescribed age limits.
16.	Can a candidate who is crossing upper age limit but having work experience apply?	No, the candidates shall be within prescribed age limits.
17.	Will the candidates presently employed with Central Government / State Government / Quasi Government Offices / Public Sector Undertakings required to produce No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their employer at the time of interview?	Yes, the candidates presently employed with Central Government / State Government / Quasi Government Offices / Public Sector Undertakings shall be required to produce NOC at the time of interview.
18.	What are the documents one can upload as a proof for Date of Birth (D.O.B)?	Certificate of Matriculation indicating D.O.B or Birth Certificate issued by authorized Govt. body like Municipal Corporation/Municipal Council.
19.	Can a candidate having degree in Fibre Science Engineering and has qualified the GATE Paper in Textile Engineering and Fibre Science apply for the post Textile Engineering?	No, the applicant must have degree in the concerned discipline against which the vacancy is advertised.
