Plea : Guilty

Finding : Guilty

Sentence or Order : Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 10,000/- each/- u/s 11 (1) r/w. 33(1) of Bureau of Indian Standard Act IDSI for 8 months each.

This case coming on to this day's proceedings the court passed the following:-

#### JUDGEMENT

This is a complaint filed by the complainant against the accused with the allegation of the commission of the offence punishable u/s. 11(1) r/w. 33(1) of Bureau of Indian Standard Act

2. Cognizance of the offence was taken and summons issued to the accused. On appearance of the accused they were furnished with the copies of relevant records. Charge framed for offence u/s 11 (1) r/w. 33(1) of Bureau of Indian Standard Act, read over and explained to the accused, and asked whether they pleading guilty or claiming to be tried. They pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that they made their plea voluntarily and hence accepted. Accused are found guilty and convicted thereunder. Heard on question of sentence. Accused are first offenders and hence they are entitled for some leniency.

4. In the result, accused are sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- each- u/s 11(1) r/w. 33(1) of Bureau of Indian Standard Act in default of payment of fine, accused shall sentenced undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 8 months.
