Course Content

ISO 22000:2018 sets out the requirements for a Food Safety Management System and can be certified to. It maps out what an organization needs to do to demonstrate its ability to control food safety hazards in order to ensure that food is safe. It can be used by any organization regardless of its size or position in the food chain. ISO 22000:2018 specifies requirements to enable an organization :-

- to plan, implement, operate, maintain and update a food safety management system aimed at providing products that, according to their intended use, are safe for the consumer,
- to demonstrate compliance with applicable statutory and regulatory food safety requirements,
- to evaluate and assess customer requirements and demonstrate conformity with those mutually agreed customer requirements that relate to food safety, in order to enhance customer satisfaction,
- to effectively communicate food safety issues to their suppliers, customers and relevant interested parties in the food chain,
- to ensure that the organization conforms to its stated food safety policy,
- to demonstrate such conformity to relevant interested parties.

Who Should Attend

The organizations which are implementing (or are in the process of implementing) Food Safety Management Systems in their organizations require their executive at middle level or senior level trained for the revised version i.e., IS/ISO 22000:2018 may nominate their employees.
