Failure modes and effects analysis also documents current knowledge and actions about the risks of failures, for use in continuous improvement. **FMEA** is an analytical method used to ensure potential problems are considered and addressed throughout the product and process development process.

FMEA is one of the most established methods for identifying hazards in new plant. It also forms the first stage of more recently developed techniques, such as Reliability Centred Maintenance (RCM), making it one of the most widely used analysis tools for reliability or availability improvement and cost reduction.
