Dr. James Jacob, Director of Rubber Research Institute of India (RRII) under the Rubber Board, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India since 2006, is a double-doctorate, a Commonwealth Fellow and a University rank holder. Dr. Jacob, a graduate in Agriculture, has a Ph.D. in Plant Physiology from University of Agricultural Sciences, Bangalore and another Ph.D. in Biochemistry from Imperial College, London.

After completing his second Ph. D. from London, Dr. Jacob joined the Smithsonian Environmental Research Centre in the United States where he worked as a scientist from 1992 to 1995. He returned to India in 1995 to take up a research career as Deputy Director at RRII after quitting a lucrative career in the US.

He was Chairman of the International Rubber Research and Development Board (IRRDB), Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia and Head of the Environmental Committee of the Association of Natural Rubber Producing Countries based in Malaysia. An able administrator with excellent leadership qualities and a highly reputed scientist, Dr. Jacob is one of the best known faces of the Indian rubber industry at national and international forums.
